## TOODIE (Add and Subtract 2-digit Numbers)



Use two metre sticks back to back with 10 cm sticks and 1 cm sticks to explore all the number pairs that make 100.

Practice giving spoken explanations as to why (eg) $64+36=100$. ' 6 tens +3 tens $=9$ tens and the extra ten units makes another ten'

Explore how to add pairs of two digit numbers by partitioning into tens and units:

$$
' 40+20=60,8+3=11 \text { so } 48+23=71^{\prime}
$$



Subtract by taking away first from tens and then from any 2-digit number:
$70-20=50$
so
$70-21=49$
$70-22=48$

Subtract by using differences:
Work with number triangles:

$$
\begin{aligned}
& 37+?=40 \\
& \text { so } \\
& 37+?=70 \\
& 37+?=60 \\
& 37+?=80
\end{aligned}
$$



So 80-37=43.
