Sometimes, homework will be a Maths Investigation! If you'd like to help, here's how!

Find the Maths Investigations website at www.mathsinvestigations.com.

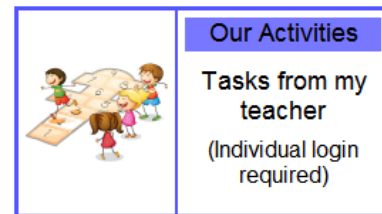
Go to the online activities page.

Login. (Your child will have been given a username and password by the teacher.)



Choose 'Our Activities'. (These are the activities that the teacher has set up for your child.)

In the list, find the activity that your child has been asked to do. Your child will have been introduced to this and may have worked through part of it already in school.



Begin with the Investigation. Work through it **together**, page by page. **Read** the instructions and **talk** about any patterns you see in the numbers.

If there is a quiz, this is for your child to do **without any help**. (If the score is not good, suggest that your child goes back and tries the investigation again.)

This is your suggested next step.
